

Shelbyville cop gets probation in plea deal

SHELBYVILLE, Ind. (WISH) - A Shelbyville Police captain pleaded guilty to official misconduct in a plea agreement.

Capt. James Douglas Hasecuster was sentenced to one year in jail, but the sentence was suspended. He'll spend a year on probation. Hasecuster had been suspended without pay by the Shelbyville Board of Public Works and Safety.

Hasecuster was originally charged with child seduction, a Class D felony; furnishing alcohol to a minor, a Class B misdemeanor; contributing to the delinquency of a minor, a Class A misdemeanor; and false informing, a Class B misdemeanor.

Those charges were dropped as part of the plea deal.

Hasecuster was accused of seducing a high school student and providing her with alcohol. He had provided security at Shelbyville High School, though hasn't since May.
