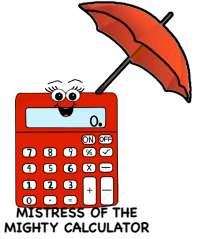


PART II-B OPERATION "DO THE MATH"



WHERE DOES THE US GOVERNMENT HIDE ALL THE STATISTICAL INFORMATION AND CRIMINAL CATEGORIES FOR THE 'MOST PRESSING ISSUE OF OUR TIME'- "HUMAN/ SEX TRAFFICKING AND MODERN DAY SLAVERY"? WHERE OH WHERE CAN THEY BE?

THERE ISN'T A DAY THAT GOES BY IN WHICH THE TOPIC OF 'SEX TRAFFICKING' IS NOT FRONT AND CENTER IN THE PRINT AND ONLINE MEDIA. MAGAZINES, NEWSPAPERS, BLOGS- EVERY SINGLE ONE OF THEM HAS SOME SORDID STORY RELATING TO THE 'CAUSE DU JOUR'- THE 'END THE DEMAND' CRUSADE- TO STOP ALL FORMS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING, BY WHICH THE POLITICIANS AND THE MEDIA MEAN 'ABOLISH PROSTITUTION AND PORNOGRAPHY.' THE OTHER LABOR TRAFFICKING GETS SHORT SHRIFT BECAUSE IT ISN'T SEXY AND NO ONE SEEMS TO CARE.

WITH ALL THE INTEREST IN THIS ISSUE, YOU WOULD THINK THAT THERE WOULD BE A SEPARATE CRIMINAL CATEGORY FOR "HUMAN TRAFFICKING" OR "SEX TRAFFICKING" BUT THERE ISN'T- AT LEAST NOT AT THE STATE LEVEL WHEN IT COMES TO REPORTING CRIMES AND ARRESTS FOR CRIME. AND THERE ARE NO SEPARATE CRIMINAL CATEGORIES FOR "PANDERING" OR "PIMPING" OR WHATEVER OTHER (USUALLY FELONY) PROSTITUTION RELATED "CRIMES" THERE ARE.

THAT'S NOT TO SAY THAT THERE AREN'T SPECIFIC LAWS RELATING TO HUMAN/ SEX TRAFFICKING OR PANDERING, PIMPING ETC. HOWEVER, WHEN IT COMES TO THE CRIMINAL REPORTING OF THE NUMBERS OF ARRESTS FOR VIOLATING THOSE LAWS, THERE IS NO SEPARATE ACCOUNTING. SUCH ARRESTS ARE LUMPED IN WITH THE "PROSTITUTION AND COMMERCIAL VICE" CATEGORY- WHICH DOESN'T SHOW WHAT PERCENTAGE OF THE (2016) ARRESTS FOR PROSTITUTION AND COMMERCIAL VICE WHICH WERE REPORTED- [30,509- OF WHICH WE KNOW FROM PAGE 9 IN PART VI, 18,794 WERE FEMALES AND UNDER 18 THERE WERE 291] WERE FOR PANDERING, PIMPING OR SEX

TRAFFICKING- OR IF THOSE ARRESTS WERE PRIMARILY FOR BEING AN ALLEGED PROSTITUTE/ 'VICTIM.'

IF THERE IS NOT A SEPARATE CRIMINAL CLASSIFICATION FOR REPORTING THOSE CRIMES TO THE FBI FOR THEIR ANNUAL REPORT "CRIME IN THE UNITED STATES," HOW DO WE KNOW WHAT THE NUMBER OF ARRESTS ARE FOR THOSE CRIMES? WHEN THE 'VICTIM PIMPS' AND GOVERNMENT AGENCIES CITE THE 'GUESSTIMATED NUMBER OF SEX TRAFFICKING OR OTHER LABOR TRAFFICKING, WHAT NUMBERS ARE THEY CITING?

WHERE CAN THOSE NUMBERS BE FOUND?

WE HAVE NO ANSWERS AND DO NOT KNOW WHO DOES. THE GOVERNMENT, THE PROSTITUTION ABOLITIONISTS AND THE 'VICTIM PIMPS' HAVE NO INCENTIVE TO MAKE SUCH INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC. IT IS ALL ABOUT PROMOTING THE 'END THE DEMAND' AGENDA. FACTS DO NOT MATTER WHEN YOU WANT TO IMPOSE YOUR MORAL OR SOCIAL VALUES ON OTHERS.

AS LONG AS THEY CAN PROJECT UNSUBSTANTIATED 'GUESSTIMATES' OF 'VICTIMS' AND THE MEDIA ASKS NO QUESTIONS- WE WILL NEVER KNOW.

PERCENTAGE OF ARRESTS FOR NON REPORTED CRIMINAL ACTIVITY: **82.28%**

UPON FIRST GLANCE, IT APPEARS THAT THERE WERE MORE ARRESTS MADE THAN THERE WERE CRIMINAL REPORTS FILED... UNTIL YOU REALIZE THAT THE MAJORITY OF ARRESTS WERE NOT FOR REPORTED CRIMES, AND IN FACT, ARRESTS FOR REPORTED CRIMES WERE ONLY **17.72%** OF ALL ARRESTS MEANING THAT OF THE **9,161,163** REPORTED CRIMES, **7,530,906** WERE NOT SOLVED AND THE PERPETRATORS ARE STILL AT LARGE.

BUT NOT TO WORRY! THE **652,936** STATE AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENTS*₂ WHO WERE OUT THERE FIGHTING CRIME WERE VERY SUCCESSFUL IN APPREHENDING ALL THOSE "CRIMINALS" WHO WERE UNFORTUNATE ENOUGH TO ENCOUNTER A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENT WHO WAS SIMPLY TOO INCOMPETENT TO FIND A CRIMINAL WHO HAD A VICTIM. IN FACT, THE AVERAGE NUMBER OF ARRESTS MADE PER COP PER YEAR IN 2016 WAS...

A STAGGERING 14.09... GOOD THING THEY REALLY ARE INCOMPETENT, OR THEY WOULD HAVE HAULED IN EVEN MORE ADULTS FOR VIOLATING THE SENSIBILITIES OF MORAL AND SOCIAL BUSYBODIES... HERE'S THE CALCULATION FOR FINDING THE AVERAGE NUMBER OF ARRESTS MADE PER COP PER YEAR:

9,197,727 ÷ BY 652,936 = 14.09 ARRESTS PER YEAR... NOT PER MONTH... PER YEAR....

CONSIDERING THAT IT TAKES, ON AVERAGE, 40 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENTS TO RESCUE ONE CHILD DURING THE ANNUAL "OPERATION CROSS COUNTRY" STING, ONE WONDERS HOW ON EARTH IT WOULD BE POSSIBLE TO "END THE DEMAND" (FOR PROSTITUTES OF ALL AGES) WHEN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT

AGENTS WE HAVE NOW CAN'T ARREST MORE THAN 18% OF ALL REPORTED CRIMES... AND WOULD THE PROSTITUTION ABOLITIONISTS REALLY CLAIM THAT IT IS MORE IMPORTANT TO SQUANDER THE SCARCE AND VALUABLE RESOURCES ARRESTING ADULT MEN AND WOMEN FOR ENGAGING IN COMMERCIAL SEX WHERE NEITHER PARTICIPANT HAS CALLED THE POLICE AND ASKED FOR HELP?

The bar above between the arrows is directly from the FBI's XLS spreadsheet - we colorized the heading row of most of the columns for so called 'vice criminal activities' to highlight those for which there was no 'reporting victim' other than the law enforcement officer making the arrest. "Forcible rape" is also noted by color solely to highlight that crime for which so few arrests were made compared to the number of reported incidents. The categories of "violent crime" and "property crime" include: murder and non negligent manslaughter, forcible rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny- theft, motor vehicle theft and arson. Crimes designated as "other assaults, forgery and counterfeiting, fraud, embezzlement, stolen property: buying/ receiving/ possessing and vandalism" most likely had a reporting victim, but the FBI stats do not include them in the 'reported crimes' table # 5 stats. So for the purposes of this document, we did not include them in the 'reported crimes' category either, because we do not know how the local law enforcement agencies reported them to the FBI.

NOTE: THERE IS NO SEPARATE CATEGORY WITHIN THESE ANNUAL REPORTS AND STATISTICS FROM THE FBI FOR 'HUMAN TRAFFICKING,' 'SEX TRAFFICKING' OR FOR 'PANDERING/ PIMPING' OR FOR NON COMMERCIAL CHILD SEXUAL EXPLOITATION/SO THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO WAY FOR ANYONE TO MAKE ANY SORT OF 'EDUCATED GUESSTIMATE' OF HOW MANY ARRESTS ARE MADE EACH YEAR FOR THOSE 'CRIMES.' WHY THERE ISN'T A 'CRIMINAL CATEGORY' FOR THOSE ACTIVITIES IS ANYONE'S GUESS. MAYBE SOME BRAVE AND DARING SOUL COULD ASK THEM.....????????

NOTE: Each state has its own individual section which is colorized by state to make the information distinguishable from information in other states. Each state section has several different information components with data from the two tables noted (#5 and #69) to give an overview of crimes reported, arrests made and the population of each state. It also has totals for various statistics which can be found on the Part II- A spreadsheet and of course from the FBI tables as noted.

THESE STATS FROM FBI "CRIME IN THE UNITED STATES" TABLE # 69 SHOW THE NUMBER OF ARRESTS FOR ALL CRIMES AND 'CRIMINAL ACTIVITY'- THOSE NUMBERS ARE THE TOP TWO ROWS FOR EACH STATE'S STATISTICS. CRIMES NOTED AS "VIOLENT CRIME" AND "PROPERTY CRIME" ARE ARRESTS FOR REPORTED CRIMES WHERE A VICTIM EITHER REPORTED A CRIME OR A REPORT WAS FILED ON BEHALF OF THE VICTIM (USUALLY FOR A HOMICIDE).
