Oceanside CA- On June 19th and 20th, members of the Oceanside Police Department's Special Enforcement Section, in conjunction with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, participated in a anti-human trafficking operation titled "Operation Cross Country". SES arrested five people for prostitution and one person for pimping on Thursday, June 19th plus an additional five people were arrested for prostitution on Friday the 20th.

Operation Cross Country is part of the FBI's Innocence Lost National Initiative and was conducted with the assistance of more than 8,500 local, state, and federal law enforcement officers representing 414 separate agencies. To date, 47 Innocence Lost Task Forces and working groups have recovered more than 2,200 children from the streets. The investigations and subsequent 1,017 convictions of pimps, madams, and their associates who exploit children through prostitution have resulted in lengthy sentences—including multiple sentences of 25 years to life in prison—and the seizure of more than \$3 million in assets.

"Child prostitution remains a major threat to children across America," said Kevin Perkins, acting executive assistant director of the FBI's Criminal, Cyber, Response, and Services Branch. "It is a violent and deplorable crime, and we are working with our partners to disrupt and put behind bars individuals and members of criminal enterprises who would sexually exploit children."

The 2014 sting operation as reported in multiple news outlets- none of them seem to get any of the stats right- or at least the same stats. In this article, it claims there were only 2,200 children recovered, while the Wisconsin article says there were 3,600- a difference of 1,400 'victims.' Above: from the sting in [Oceanside California \(Osie News.com\)](#) June 23rd, 2014: It does not appear that any of those arrested were minors, although the FBI claims it recovered 2 minors in San Diego... but this sting used "MORE THAN 8,500 local, state and federal law enforcement agents" to 'recover' 168 minors in 106 cities? Statistically, this is the worst year yet. See chart next page for more info on how many cops it took to 'rescue/ recover' ONE minor...

"more than 8,500" law enforcement agents to 'rescue' 168 minors in the 2014 sting? Why, that's an astonishing rescue rate of 50 agents per ONE CHILD RECOVERED! [and in 106 cities, that amounts to an average of 1.58 child per city... a major epidemic for SURE!]

"operation cross country was a week long action..." that took place from June 19 to 21... which is THREE DAYS- NOT ONE WEEK... SO, WHICH WAS IT? 3 DAYS OR 7 DAYS? CAN ANYONE COUNT? ARE THEY ALL SMOKING CRACK?

"to date, (over 11 years) the FBI and its task force partners have recovered NEARLY 3,600 children from the streets..." (as quoted from the FBI press release June 23, 2014) but the other article says "to date, Innocence Lost task forces and working groups have recovered more than 2,200 children from the streets"- a significant difference of 1,400 children- and over the 8 different stings conducted during this period from 2003 to 2014, that means 275 per year if there were 2,200, but 450 per year if there were 'nearly 3,600...' And in a different FBI press release (June 23, 2014) Special Agent Perryn Collier states "To date, the FBI and its task force partners have recovered MORE THAN 3,560 children from being exploited..." HOW MUCH "MORE THAN"????

### Polaris Project overview of the poor sex slaves:

#### Statistics Snapshot

- Standard price for 15 minutes of sex at a Residential Brothel: \$30
- Standard day for a woman or child at a Residential Brothel: 10am – 10pm; 12 hours; 7 days a week
- Estimated number of men a woman or child must have sex with daily: 25 – 48 men daily

**Child Exploitation:** \$10.8 million and 20 positions (4 agents) to enhance child exploitation investigations and prevent child predator advances before they begin. Studies estimate between 200,000 and 300,000 children are being forced into prostitution at any given time in the United States. 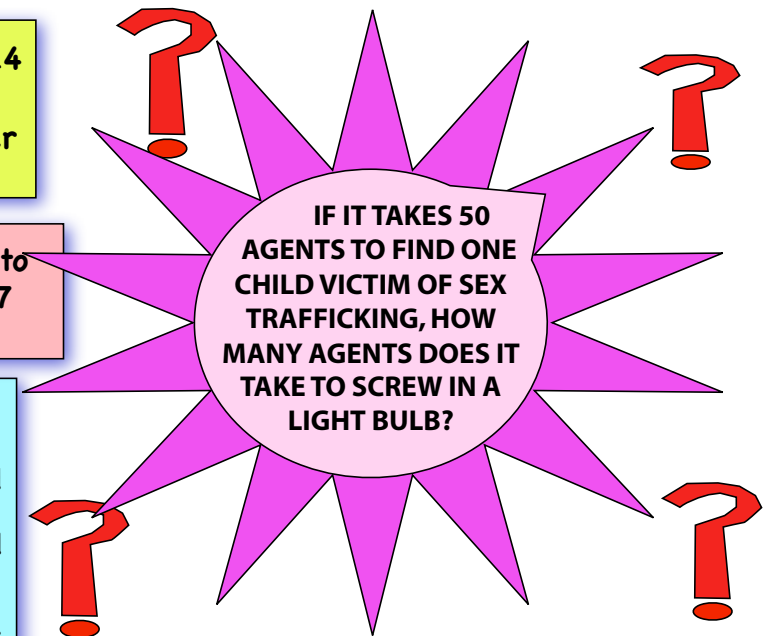

The investigations and subsequent 1,450 convictions have resulted in lengthy sentences, including 14 life terms and the seizure of more than \$3.1 million in assets." [we note that the government continues to claim that human trafficking is a \$32 BILLION a year criminal enterprise... so how is it that they were only able to seize \$3.1 MILLION over the 11 year period?- that's \$387,500 PER YEAR THEY HAVE SEIZED... BUT IT COST FAR MORE THAN THAT TO CONDUCT THE STING- AT LEAST \$85 MILLION OVER THE FOUR YEARS - (agents, travel, food, transportation, etc.)

This report also claimed that "Operation Cross Country was a week-long enforcement action to address commercial child sex trafficking across the country..." and yet, others reported that the sting took place from June 19 to the 21st... three days- not a week.

Surely, if this statistic was even HALF true - where were those children when there were 8,500 cops looking for them in 2014, and from 2011 to 2014, when a combined total 8,500 cops were combing the streets and the internet looking for them? Whether it was 2,200 or 3,600 children rescued/ recovered over the 11 year period (2003- 2014) and the 8 sting operations they conducted, wouldn't you think that these experienced law enforcement agents with ALL THOSE RESOURCES at their fingertips (hundreds of millions of dollars) they could find at least ONE CHILD PER AGENT rather than 40 AGENTS PER CHILD?

AND WHAT ABOUT THE 96% OF CHILD SEXUAL EXPLOITATION VICTIMS WHOSE PREDATORS ARE NOT BUYING THE SERVICES OF CHILDREN? (pages 92- 93) WHO WILL RESCUE THEM FROM THE PILLARS OF THE COMMUNITY INCLUDING THE NUMEROUS COPS WHO RAPE MINORS?

**SUMMARY OF THE "SUCCESS" OF THESE "OPERATION CROSS COUNTRY" STING OPERATIONS:**

In the period from 2011 to 2016, over a total of 18 OR 22 days (3 days each year OTHER THAN 2014 when some sources claim it was a week long event), it took 17,900 agents to arrest and 'rescue' a total of 1,674 people: (NOTE: adult sex workers were categorized as "pimps" in some cities and there may have been more arrests of adult sex workers than were noted in the press releases, but even if we doubled the number of arrested persons who were NOT minors, the results would still be quite low, considering the 'guesstimated number' of alleged victims of all ages and the number of alleged pimps exploiting said 'alleged victims...')

- 652 children
- 1.022 pimps
- in 414 cities

(even if the same city hosted a raid all four years, each year it counts as one city) = 93 arrests/ rescues per day, if 18 days (3, 3, 3, 3) = 71 arrests/ rescues per day if 22 days (3, 3, 3, 7= 16) and 4 rescues/ arrests per city (1,674 ÷ 414= 3.3) and 11 agents per arrest and rescue combined. Removing the arrested pimps from the equation,

**it took an average of 27.5 agents to find and rescue one child.**

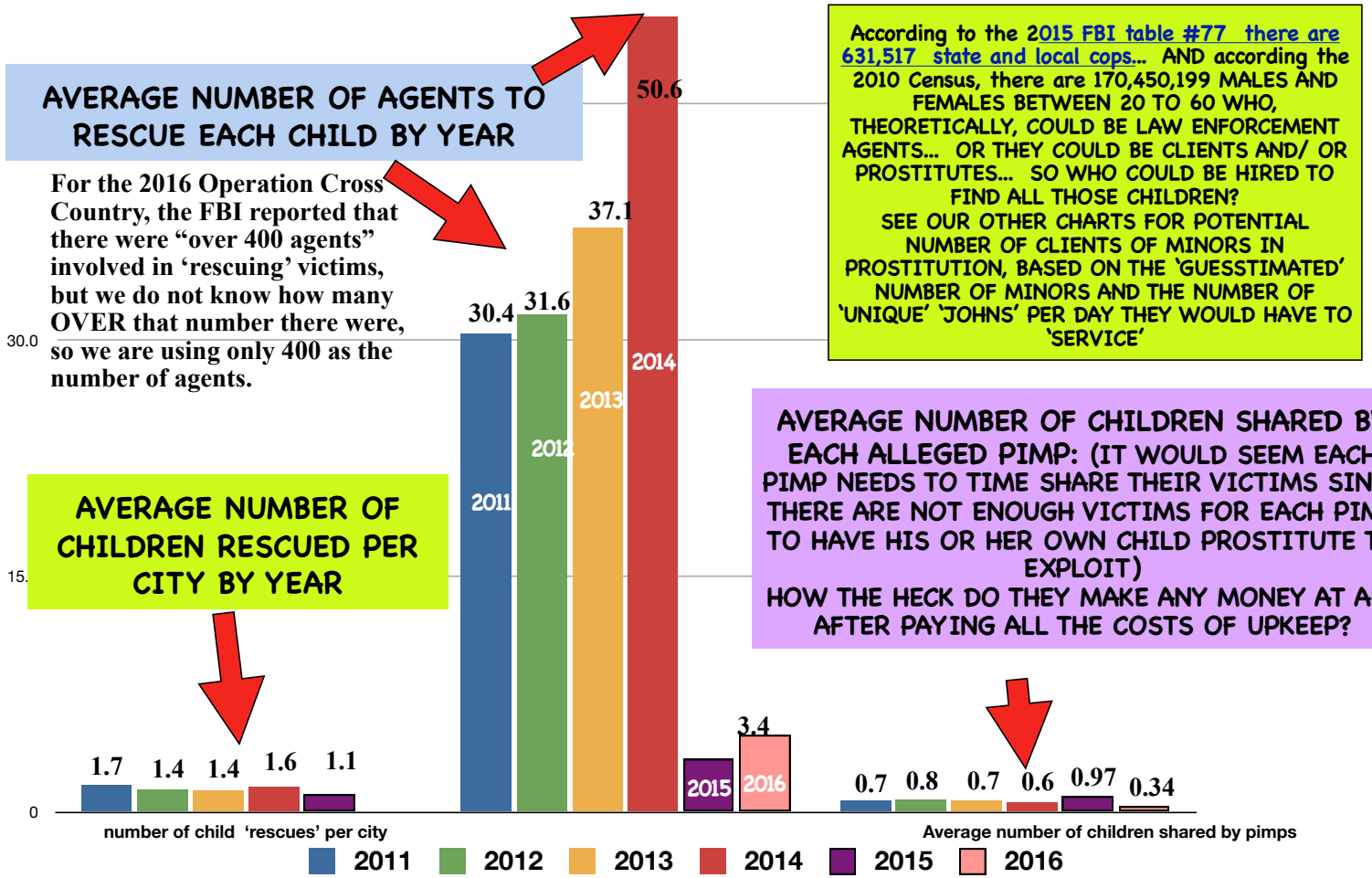
If there really are 100,000 children trafficked into the sex industry every year, (leaving out the 100,000 from each year previous who are still being trafficked) at the rate these fine officers were able to rescue the grand total of 652 children in those 18/22 days over six years, it would have taken an additional 16,454,493 officers to locate and rescue the 599,348 children who were not located using the detective skills of the 17,000 agents. If there are at least 200,000 children trafficked into prostitution every year as the Polaris Project and other Prostitution Abolitionist Organizations claim, then we would need an additional 32,926,885 cops to find the missing 1,199,348 children (over 6 years).

Unfortunately, there are only about 900,000 federal, state and local law enforcement officers (of which 631,517 are state and local officers) currently employed, so even if ALL OF THEM conducted no other criminal investigations except to look for child victims over the same 18/22 days in six years, there would not be sufficient law enforcement agents to find them. On average, law enforcement agents nationwide manage to make 14.38 arrests PER YEAR (according to the 2015 tables # 5 and #69 statistics from the FBI, as shown in Part II-A), very few of which are related to crimes with victims who have reported the crime and asked for help.

With all these law enforcement agents out there looking for them, why can't more 'child victims' be found? In 2015, state by state (TABLE #69), there were a grand total of 457 minors arrested for prostitution. Because by 'rescue' they actually mean "arrest." Even children under 10 are ARRESTED, put in handcuffs and traumatized by being tossed into a jail cell until they were either released to the custody of their parents (where they may have been the victim of incest) or sent to live in a foster home or other locked down facility. While in custody, many of them are victims of rape at the hands of the guards or other inmates.

"Since its creation in 2003, the Innocence Lost program has resulted in the identification and recovery of approximately 3,600 minors who have been sexually exploited. This year marks the eighth Operation Cross Country, the largest such enforcement action to date: 168 trafficking victims were recovered and 281 pimps were arrested." Which years (between 2003 and 2014) did they skip doing a sting operation? This is an eleven year period, so they should be on Operation Cross Country XI, but the 2016 sting was Operation Cross Country X.

As usual, the FBI bragged about the success of the 2016 sting- claiming that it had recovered more children IN 2016 than any previous year.

In 2014 it took a total of 8,500 agents in 106 cities over either 3 or 7 days to rescue 168 victims...

How is that a success by ANY standard- if, out of an alleged 100,000 to 300,000 children trafficked into prostitution each year, they manage to find .042% to 0.021%?
