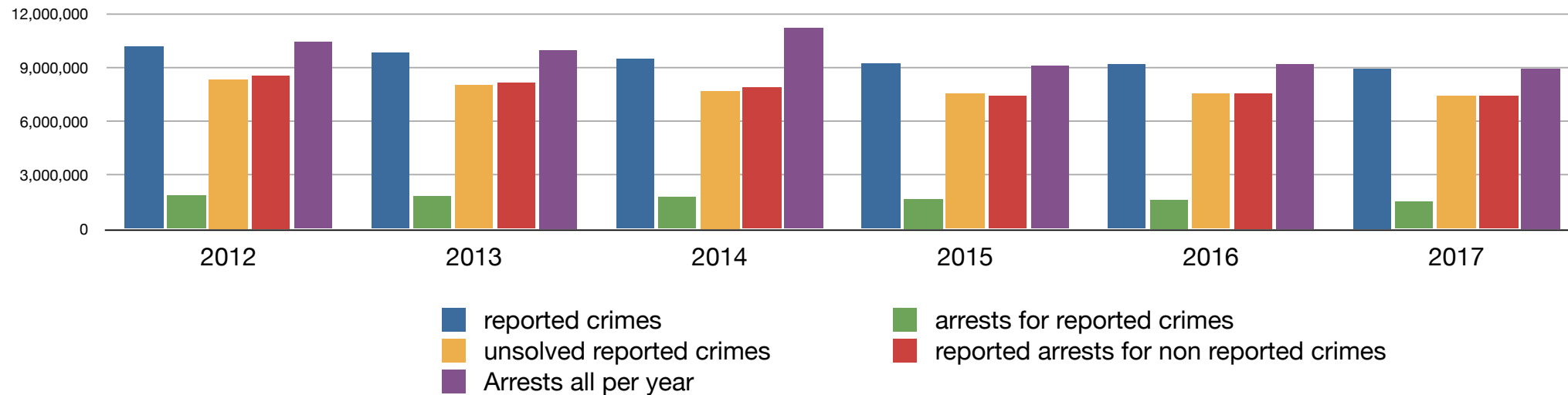

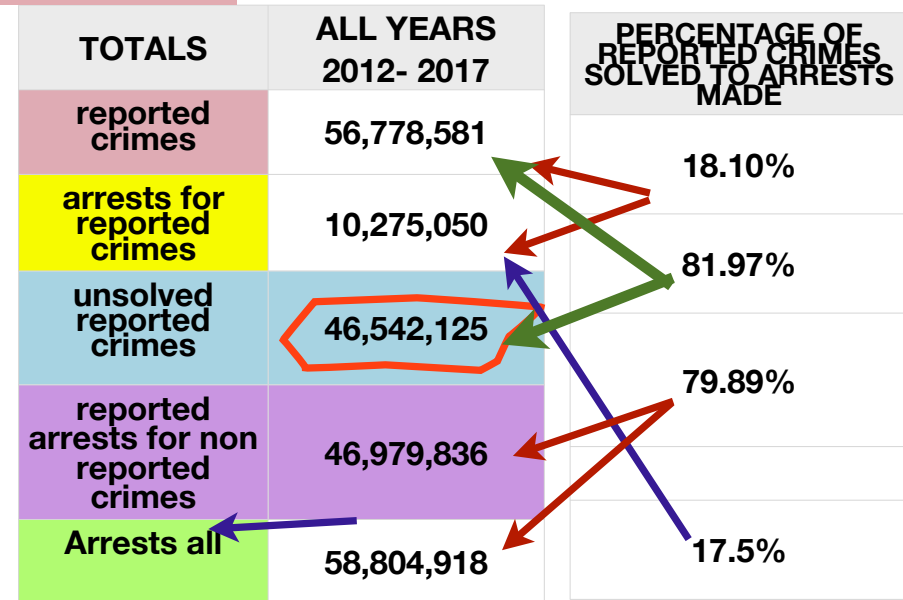
These charts and graphs represent the number of reported crimes (both violent and property crimes) from 2012 to 2017 using the FBI Bureau of Justice Statistics -NOTE: from 2012 to 2015, the tables used were #5 (reported crimes) and #69 (reported arrests). In 2016, the FBI changed the table numbers for this data tables #3 for reported crimes and table # 22 for reported arrests. They returned to original table numbers in 2017.

2012- 2017 REPORTED CRIMES, ARRESTS FOR REPORTED CRIMES AND ARRESTS FOR NON REPORTED CRIMES

This graph represents the number of reported crimes (both violent and property crimes) from 2012 to 2017 using the FBI Bureau of Justice Statistics -NOTE: from 2012 to 2015, the tables used were #5 (reported crimes) and #69 (reported arrests). In 2016, the FBI changed the table numbers for this data and are now tables #3 for reported crimes and table # 22 for reported arrests. The table numbers were restored and can be found as table #5 (reported crimes) and #69 (reported arrests all)

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THERE WERE **46,542,125 UNSOLVED REPORTED CRIMES CRIMES 2012- 2017**

while there were **58,804,918** arrests made. **79.89%** of *all arrests* were for activities that **did not have a victim who reported being a victim** - activities such as gambling, drugs, prostitution, curfew violation, “suspicion” (*of what we do not know*), and “all other offenses” which are not defined. Only

**17.5%** of **all arrests** were for reported crimes- while **18.1%** (or **10,275,050** arrests) out of **56,778,581** reported crimes were solved.

There were **46,542,125 UNSOLVED REPORTED CRIMES DURING THIS PERIOD OR 81.97% OF ALL REPORTED CRIMES UNSOLVED.** .
