Overview

- Nationwide, law enforcement made an estimated <u>10,310,960</u> arrests in 2018. Of these arrests, <u>521,103</u> were for violent crimes, and <u>1,167,296</u> were for property crimes. (Note: the UCR Program does not collect data on citations for traffic violations.) (See <u>Table 29</u>.)
- The highest number of arrests were for drug abuse violations (estimated at 1,001,329), and larceny-theft (estimated at 887,622). (See <u>Table 29</u>.)

<u>Violent crime</u> is composed of four offenses: <u>murder and nonnegligent manslaughter</u>, <u>rape</u>, <u>robbery</u>, and <u>aggravated assault</u>. Violent crimes are defined in the UCR Program as those offenses that involve force or threat of force.

The Violent Crime section of this report provides more information about violent crime and an overview of violent crime data for 2018.

The <u>2018 Criminal Victimization Report</u> shows a significantly greater number of rapes and sexual assaults than are reported in the <u>2018 FBI Table #5- (reported crimes by state)</u>. Additionally, there is a HUGE increase from the 2017 rape/ sexual assault cases... nearly double the number and the highest number of cases since the Criminal Victimization Report has been published.

Also note that in Table #69, there are no numbers for the arrests for domestic violence/ intimate partner violence.
