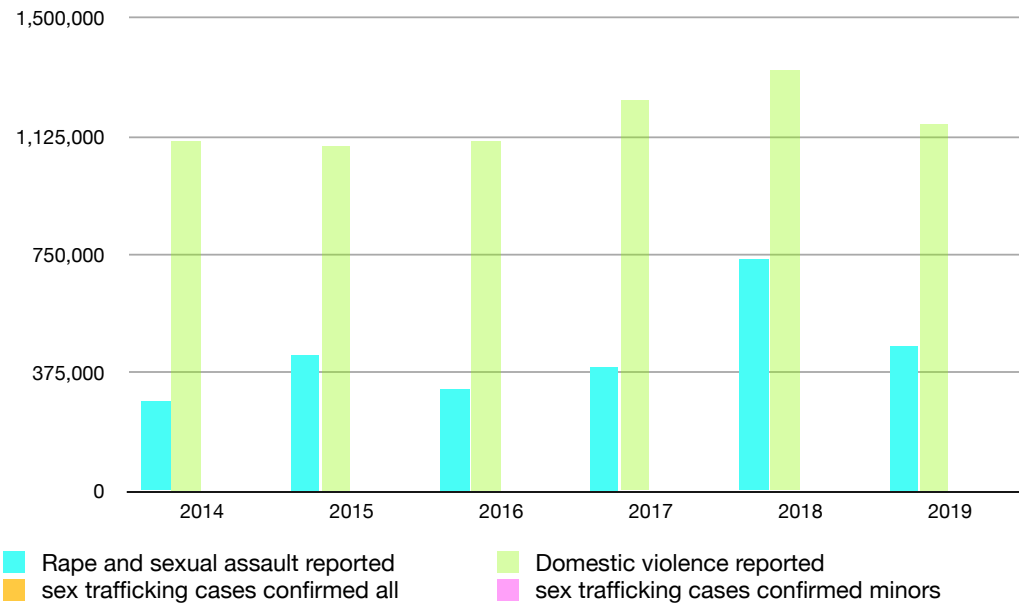

There are so few confirmed cases of sex trafficking of either adults or minors that they do not show up on the chart above...

From 2017 to 2018, rapes and sexual assaults have nearly doubled... the highest number these reported rapes and sexual assaults have EVER been- with the lowest percentage of arrests for those reported rapes and sexual assaults. The numbers came down in 2019, but there are still far far too many cases!

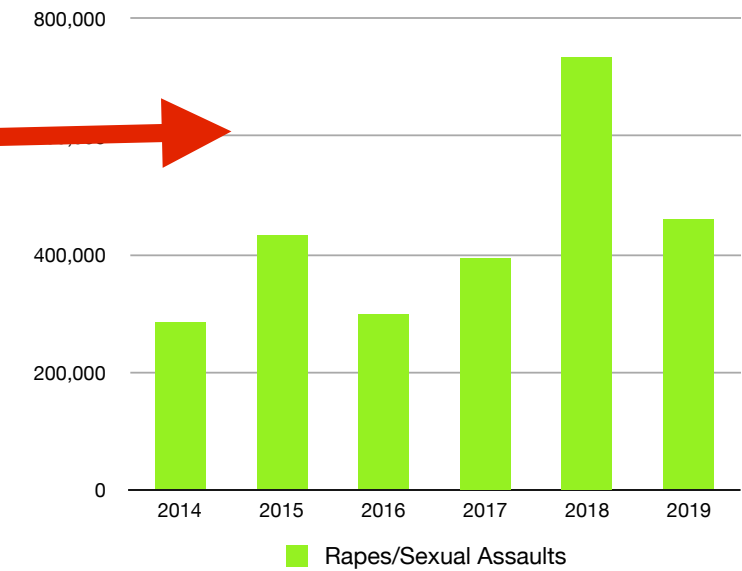


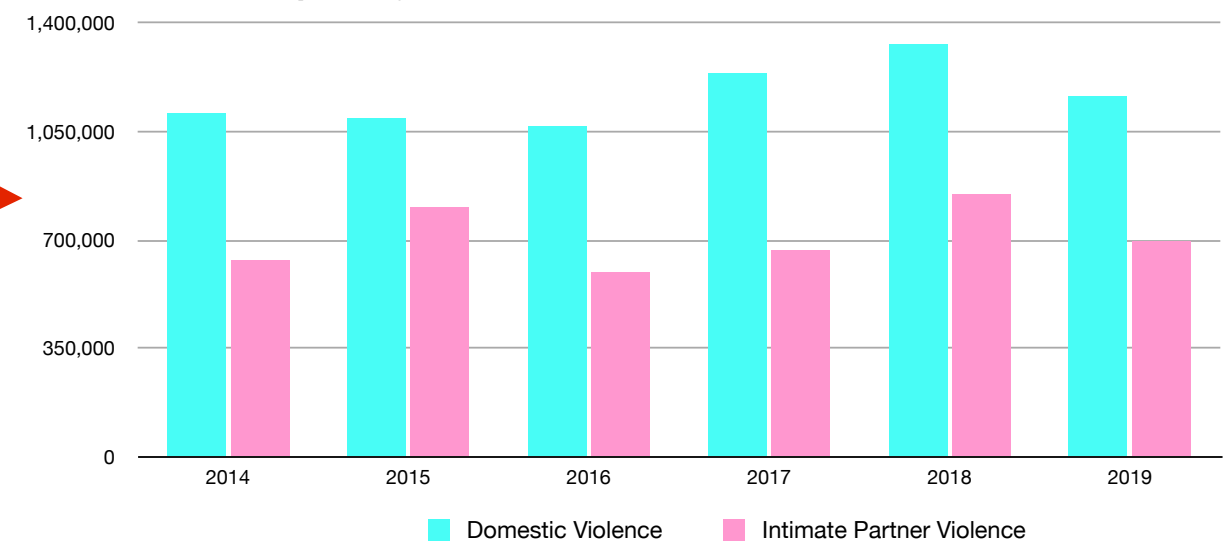
