The event occurred on 2-20-09 at approximately 1708 at 900 10TH ST NW #503 in Washington DC.




Members of the Narcotic Special Investigation Division Prostitution Enforcement Unit (PEU) conducted a covert prostitution operation in conjunction with the Federal Bureau of Investigation Operation Cross Country at the "Embassy Suites Hotel". PEU utilized the website WWW.CRAIGSLIST.COM erotic section to post ads utilizing two female undercover (UC) officers posing as a prostitutes. PEU also used male undercover (UC) officers to contact females off of ads posted on the website. This website is highly utilized by prostitutes and johns to make arrangements to have sexual encounters for the exchange for money. PEU pre-wired the hotel room utilized by the UC to record the offense in video and sound.

U/C: HOW YOU DOING?  
D-1: I'M GOOD. THIS IS A REALLY NICE ROOM.  
U/C: I'M GLAD YOU LIKE IT. SO, WHAT DO YOU DO FOR A LIVING?  
D-1: I WORK WITH THE GOVERNMENT.  
U/C: HOW COOL IS THAT!!! SO, WHAT YOU WANT?  
D-1: HALF HOUR.  
U/C: THAT'S GOING TO BE \$80.00.  
U/C: \$80.00 FOR SEX RIGHT.  
D-1: WELL, I'LL DO A LITTLE OF LICKING. DO YOU LIKE THAT?  
U/C: WHAT?  
D-1: WHEN SOMEONE GOES DOWN ON YOU?  
U/C: OFCOURSE, I LIKE EVERYTHING.  
D-1: LET ME GET COMFORTABLE I'LL BE RIGHT BACK.

The pre-arranged signal was given and PEU arrest team conducted a stop and placed D1 under arrest for the listed offense. D-1 was identified as SCHMIDT, ROBERT.

The events and acts described above occurred primarily in the District of Columbia and were committed as described by defendant(s) listed in the case caption.
