

Ex-policeman robbed by alleged pimps

A former Northwest police lieutenant charged in the solicitation of a minor for sex was the victim of an armed robbery at the hands of the men who allegedly pimped out the teen girl he had a rendezvous with, a press release Thursday states.

Kyle Bradley Wolfe, 20, is charged with attempted armed robbery, discharging a weapon into a motor vehicle, breaking and entering, and larceny after breaking and entering in the Nov. 27 incident on Reidsville Road. Sean Conley, 20, and Matthew Dillon Vaczy, 19, are each charged with aiding and abetting an armed robbery, breaking and entering,

larceny after breaking and entering, larceny of a firearm and safe cracking.

According to a press release from the Boiling Spring Lakes Police Department, Northwest police Lt. Michael Hayes fell victim to the trio after he met with a 17-year-old girl he paid \$60 for sex.

Hayes, 38, who has since resigned from the Northwest Police Department, surrendered to police Wednesday morning on charges of solicitation of a minor for sex and filing a false police report.

According to the warrant, Hayes contacted the girl via Craigslist.org and met with her Nov. 27.

Later that day he allegedly reported to the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office that a private vehicle he was driving was fired on as he traveled along River Road near Sunnypoint.

Wolfe and Conley were each charged May 4 with two counts of promoting prostitution of a minor.

Conley, Wolfe and Vaczy also are charged in connection with a residential burglary Nov. 20 on Raeford Road in Boiling Spring Lakes.

A fourth man, Richard Kyle Mulligan, 23, surrendered on a warrant Thursday charging him with participating in prostitution of a minor.
