

2nd trial under way for ex-cop

Following a jury deadlock in Santa Cruz County in May, testimony began Tuesday in a new trial of former Nogales Police Officer Ramon Fernando Borbon, this time in Pima County Superior Court. Borbon is facing charges of kidnapping and sexual assault.

In May, he was tried on the same allegations in Santa Cruz County Superior Court, but after four weeks of testimony, the hearing was declared a mistrial. The proceedings were moved to Pima County, although it is still considered a local case and is being heard by Santa Cruz County Presiding Judge James A. Soto.
