(WHAS11) - The sheriff of Harrison County, Indiana, Mike Deatruck, was back on the job, Monday, April 5. His return to work comes only days after being indicted by a grand jury.

Deatruck was indicted late Thursday night for 12 felony counts.

The grand jury met for 18 months before indicting him. They found there was evidence that Deatruck groped and fondled two female employees against their will.

Under Indiana state law, Deatruck doesn't have to step down.. He would have to be

convicted of a felony to be forcibly removed.

Meanwhile, the Harrison County jail commander who was also indicted Thursday night has turned himself in. Nathan Simpson is charged with obstruction of justice and false informing.
