## Ex-FBI agent pleads guilty in Hershey bathroom peeping

A former FBI agent has pleaded guilty to all charges stemming from an incident in a girls' bathroom at the Hershey Middle School.

Ryan Seese, 36, of Hershey, entered the plea Tuesday morning in Dauphin County court. The charges include criminal trespass, invasion of privacy, and disorderly conduct.

Authorities said Seese went into a bathroom stall during a May 15 evening concert and peered over a wall to watch a 14-year-old girl. Surveillance cameras show that he loitered around the area for 45 minutes until the girl went into the restroom, officials said.

Seese lost his job with the FBI in 2007, after he was caught inside a women's bathroom at the University of Arizona.

A sentencing hearing was scheduled for Nov. 10.
