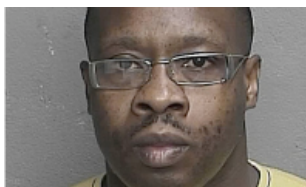

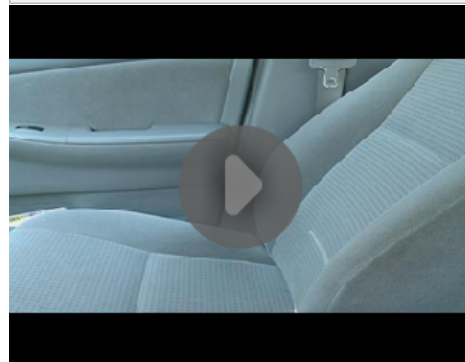

A Bryan patrol officer is on paid administrative leave after College Station police arrested him on a charge of indecent exposure.

Adam Lamar Brooks, of Anderson, has been on leave since Tuesday, in anticipation of a warrant being issued. Officers arrested him Thursday morning.

The probable cause statement released by the College Station Police Department states Brooks, 42, admitted to taking part in similar activities in the past.

On November 4, 2010, College Station Police responded to the Post Oak Mall at 1500 Harvey Road in reference to a suspicious person. They received reports of a male suspect exposing his genitals while inside his vehicle at the mall parking lot.

Responding officers checked the mall area, but were unable to locate the suspect. They did obtain information identifying about the suspect's vehicle.

On February 24, 2011, Post Oak Mall security officers contacted CSPD and reported the same vehicle was back at the mall. Officers located the vehicle and identified the driver. Brooks was given a warning for criminal trespassing and released.

Through further investigation, College Station Police believe the person located on February 24, 2011 was the same suspect who exposed his genitals on November 4, 2010.

On Wednesday, March 9, 2011, investigators obtained a warrant for the arrest of the suspect for indecent exposure. The warrant was served Thursday.

Brooks was off-duty when the incident occurred. He is charged with indecent exposure, a Class B Misdemeanor.

"I was surprised, disappointed and saddened because he has a good record as a Bryan police officer," said Chief Eric Buske, Bryan Police Department.

Brooks will remain on administrative leave pending the outcome of an internal investigation and administrative review.

"These are serious allegations," said Chief Buske. "We are taking our internal investigation seriously."

If convicted, Brooks could pay up to a \$2,000 fine and/or serve 180 days in jail.

Brooks has been with Bryan PD for eight years. He is a decorated Army veteran, who has served in Iraq. The Bryan City Council also gave him an award for saving a child's life.

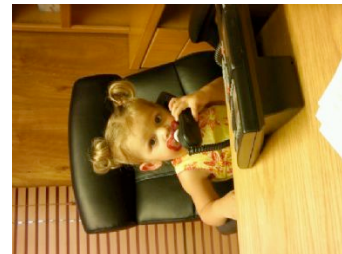
