COLLEGE STATION (March 10, 2011)--A Bryan patrol officer was arrested Thursday by College Station police on a misdemeanor warrant charging indecent exposure.

Adam Lamar Brooks, 42 of Anderson, has been on administrative leave since Tuesday, in anticipation of a warrant being issued.

On Nov. 4, 2010, College Station police responded to the Post Oak Mall at 1500 Harvey Road after they received reports that a man was exposing his genitals while inside his vehicle at the mall parking lot.

Officers checked the mall area.

They were unable to locate the man, but they did obtain information identifying the vehicle the man was in.

On Feb. 24, 2011, Post Oak Mall security officers contacted College Station police and reported the same vehicle involved in the Nov. 4, 2010 incident was back at the mall.

Officers located the vehicle and identified the driver, who was given a criminal trespass warning for the Post Oak Mall and released.

After further investigation, College Station Police determined the person given the warning on Feb. 24 was the same man who exposed his genitals in November.

On Wednesday, investigators got an arrest warrant for Brooks.

The incident occurred while Brooks was off-duty.

He was charged with indecent exposure, a class B misdemeanor.

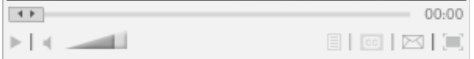
He will remain on administrative leave pending the outcome of an internal investigation and administrative review.

Brooks has been with Bryan Police Department for eight years.
