The Marion County Sheriff's Department fired a jail security officer Friday after fellow employees accused him of sexual battery.

Maurice Frazier, a 12-year employee, faces four counts of sexual battery, two counts of official misconduct and one count of criminal confinement. He was a former lietenant, assigned to jail security.

According to court documents, two women accused Frazier of touching them sexually, under threat. The victims said the incidents occurred in April.

The Marion County Sheriff's Department has zero tolerance for criminal misconduct within our ranks," Sheriff John R. Layton said, adding, "This further demonstrates that we in public safety are bound by the same laws as the people that we serve."
