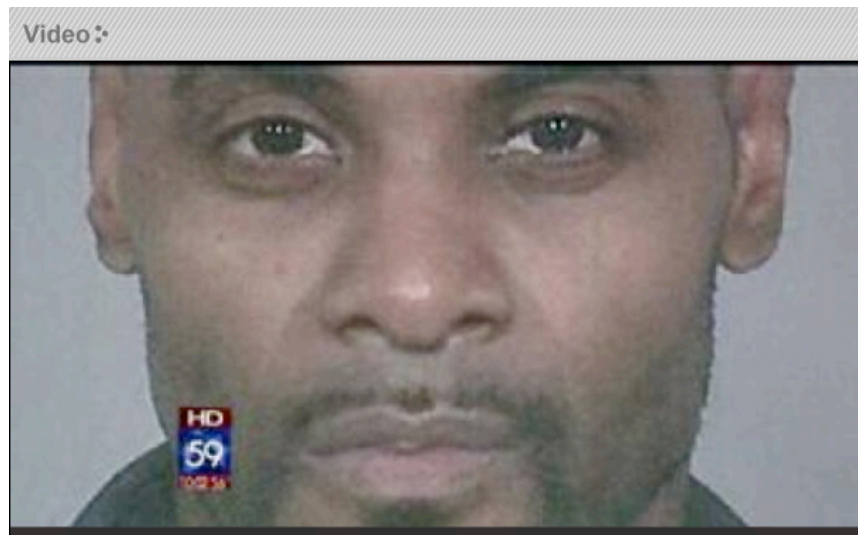

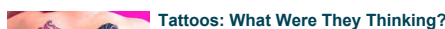
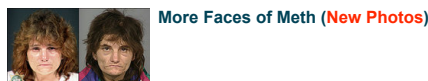

Section of the Jail Division, has been charged with several felony counts.

Frazier faces seven charges, six of them felonies. Frazier is accused of sexual battery, official misconduct and criminal confinement. The allegations stem from fellow female employees.

"His victims happen to be other deputies female deputy sheriffs. This has been going on for a little while I'm guesstimating by the sounds of things six weeks and they were tired of his advances," Marion County Sheriff John Layton said.

When Frazier supposedly asked one of the alleged victims if she would fool around with him, she answered that she was married and a reverend of a church on East 38th Street.

Frazier was confronted on the allegations and reportedly said he was a sex addict and couldn't help himself.

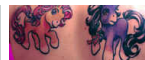
"We're talking about two other deputy sheriffs who were on duty at the time and for whatever reason he was drawn to them according to the affidavit and it went from there," Layton said.

The sheriff said this came as a shock to him.

"Knowing him as I had for all the years, I had high hopes for this deputy and that's what makes it all the more troubling," Layton said.

Layton released the following remarks about the case:

"The Marion County Sheriff's Department has a zero tolerance for criminal misconduct within our ranks. Out internal/criminal investigation was promptly and properly conducted. The Department appreciates the Marion County prosecutor working with us. This further demonstrates that we in public safety are bound by the same laws as the people that we serve. The public should demand no less, as we are their servants."
