

OKC police officer accused of sex crimes bonds out of jail

Protestors gathered outside the jail on Thursday protesting the release of an Oklahoma City police officer accused of several sex crimes.

Daniel Holtzclaw bonded out again after his 14 day sentence for violating his bond rules.

Protestors were waiting outside jail chanting "26 counts, no bail."

Holtzclaw was arrested in August on accusations of rape, oral sodomy and other charges.

Holtzclaw's bond was raised an additional \$109,000 earlier in October after he allegedly went to a non-emergency eye doctor without permission.

Daniel Holtzclaw is facing 26 counts of sex crimes involving 10 women reportedly while on the job.

Additional charges have not been filed but are expected.

According to the charges, the crimes started in February and continued through July.

Holtzclaw has said he is not guilty and his family is fighting to maintain his innocence.
