A judge charged with groping a 10-year-old girl at a Hilary Duff concert has pleaded no contest to indecent assault. The judge, Mark Pazuhanich, 47, said in court Monday that he would resign as a Monroe County judge. Mr. Pazuhanich was sentenced to 10 years probation after pleading no contest to two counts of indecent assault, one count of endangering the welfare of a child and one count of corruption of minors, all misdemeanors. He also must register as a sex offender and cooperate with an evaluation to determine if he is a sexually violent predator.
