National Briefing | Mid-Atlantic: Pennsylvania: Judge And Fondling

A former prosecutor charged with fondling a 10-year-old girl at a concert was sworn in as a Monroe County judge. The judge, Mark Pazuhanych, took his oath in private after county officials asked him not to attend a ceremony for elected officials. The county's president judge immediately barred Mr. Pazuhanych from hearing cases. Elected in November, Mr. Pazuhanych, a Republican, was in the final weeks of his term as Monroe County's district attorney when he was cited for public drunkenness and was then charged several days later with three misdemeanors, indecent assault, corrupting a minor and endangering the welfare of a child.
