Police say a part-time Sedgwick officer facing charges of taking indecent liberties with a child has been suspended and will be fired if found guilty.
Anthony Peluso is charged with seven felonies, including aggravated criminal sodomy and aggravated indecent liberties. He remains jailed on a \$100,000 bond with a preliminary hearing set for next Wednesday.
The 28-year-old Peluso is accused of molesting a girl on at least three occasions, the first time when she was 13, between December 2003 and January.
Peluso worked as a city of Sedgwick police officer for two or three months before his arrest. Police Chief Ray Huff said Peluso was one of the city's six part-time officers.
He also worked previously for two years in Valley Center before resigning in September 2001 over scheduling conflicts.
