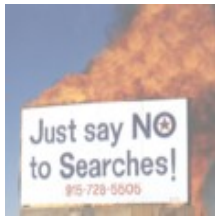

05/16/2006 - TUCSON, Ariz. A police officer on the Tohono O'odham Indian reservation has been arrested after being accused of sexually molesting an eleven-year-old-girl.

Police say the girl was baby-sitting the officer's children.

The children are six and nine years old.

Police say the officer hired the girl to watch the kids while he and his wife went to a party Saturday night.

Police say the officer returned home at about four a-m and had been drinking. The babysitter, who had been asleep at the time, woke to find him molesting her.

Thirty-three-year-old officer Michael J. Henry was booked into Pima County jail on suspicion of child molestation and sexual misconduct with a minor.

The patrol officer has worked seven years for the O'odham police.
