## Former Alhambra Police Sergeant Pleads Guilty to Child Molestation

**LOS ANGELES** – A former Alhambra police sergeant pleaded guilty today to molesting two teenage boys, the District Attorney's office announced.

Deputy District Attorney Renee Korn of the Justice System Integrity Division said Michael James Fisher, 42, entered the plea prior to the start of his scheduled preliminary hearing in Los Angeles Superior Court.

Fisher was charged last August with molesting one of the victims during an eight-month period in 2003. The second victim, according to the complaint, was molested in 2005 and 2006. Both victims were in their mid-teens at the time the crimes occurred.

Korn said Los Angeles Superior Court Judge Luis Lavin allowed Fisher to remain free on \$100,000 bail pending sentencing on Jan. 9. The prosecutor said Fisher will be sentenced to three years in state prison.

Fisher pleaded guilty to five felony counts involving both victims. Five remaining counts are scheduled to be dismissed at the time of sentencing.

The Alhambra Police Department suspended the defendant around the time of his arrest on Aug. 14. The criminal case against him was filed on Aug. 30. Fisher later left the police department.
