

Sheriff's Deputy Arrested for Indecency With a Child

LIBERTY, May 4, 2006 - The Liberty County Grand Jury indicted William Tullos, age 30, on May 4, 2006, for Indecency With a Child, which is a 2nd Degree Felony. Indecency With a Child is defined as sexual contact with a child under the age of 17. Tullos has been a Deputy with the Liberty County Sheriff's Office since July 1, 2002.

Texas Ranger Frank Huff received the allegations from authorities in Montgomery County after the original allegations were made to them. He immediately informed Sheriff Arthur of the allegations. Tullos was placed on administrative leave April 10, 2006, pending the outcome of the investigation. Sheriff Arthur assigned investigators from the Liberty County Sheriff's Office assisted Ranger Huff in the criminal investigation and also to conduct an Internal Affairs investigation.

Tullos was arrested on May 4, 2005, by Texas Ranger Frank Huff and investigators from the Liberty County Sheriff's Office. His bond was set at \$35,000 by 253rd District Court Judge, Chap Cain.

Tullos was terminated as a Deputy with the Liberty County Sheriff's Office shortly after his arrest.
