## Two Clackamas County sheriff's deputies arrested

The deputies were arrested on charges stemming from two separate incidents

**Two Clackamas County Sheriff's Office deputies** were arrested today on official misconduct and other charges stemming from two separate incidents.

Don Mainero, 31, was charged with one count of misdemeanor sex abuse and two counts of contributing to the delinquency of a minor. The sheriff's office said the charges stem from Mainero's

suspected sexual misconduct with a then-17-year-old who was a member of the sheriff's office Cadet Program, and later served in a non-sworn capacity with the office.

Clackamas County Sheriff's Office began investigating Mainero July 24 when another member of the office reported the alleged misconduct. Mainero was placed on administrative leave the next day, and resigned his position this morning, August 16, before being booked at the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office Jail.

Bryan Lavigne, 36, was charged with one count of strangulation and one count of assault along with official misconduct after members of the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office Patrol reported that he used excessive force while arresting someone July 15.

On July 16, Marion County Sheriff's Office was asked to assist with a formal investigation, which resulted in Lavigne's arrest August 16.
