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Former Marysville police officer Pavlovich gets 10+ years in molestation cases

The former Marysville police officer who was convicted of molesting and propositioning girls and women was sentenced to 10 to 26 years in state prison this morning. During Robert J. Pavlovich Jr.'s sentencing in Perry County Court in New Bloomfield, the 41-year-old Lower Allen Twp. man was found to be a sexually violent predator. He will be subject to Megan's Law requirements, including lifetime address registration with state police.

Pavlovich was convicted in October of charges that included corruption of minors, involuntary deviate sexual intercourse and indecent assault. In October 2007, Pavlovich was accused of molesting or propositioning 15 females, ages 12 to 19, while on duty in Marysville, between 2000 and 2007.
