






Former Brownwood Officer Pleads Guilty

A former Brownwood police officer has been sentenced to a pair of 20-year prison terms after a quilty plea earlier today.

District Attorney Michael Murray says that Vincent Ariaz plead quilty to sexual assault and indecency with a child.

The case stems from Ariaz's involvement with the Brownwood Police Cadets program. He was accused of improper relationships with at least two cadets. Incidents last year were actually recorded on surveillance videotape by investigators including Texas Ranger Nick Hanna, the Crime Task Force and officers from the Brownwood Police an County Sheriff's departments.

Ariaz will serve two, 20-year prison terms concurrently.

Representatives of the victim's families were in the courtroom when the guilty plea and sentencing were announced.
