Pueblo FBI agent jailed in child-sex case

A Pueblo FBI agent has been arrested for investigation of child sexual assault by someone in a position of trust, officials say.

David A. Johnson, 53, of Pueblo West was arrested Sunday at his home and is being held in the Pueblo County Jail in lieu of \$100,000 bail, Sheriff Kirk Taylor said.

Sheriff's investigators began their investigation Jan. 2, Taylor said, and it is continuing, he said.

Johnson was placed in the medical ward of the jail for his safety because he is a law-enforcement officer, Taylor said.

The arrest-warrant affidavit has been sealed in the case.

Special Agent Renee Vonder Haar, a spokeswoman for the FBI in Denver, said Johnson has been placed on administrative leave. She said she couldn't comment further.
