, in 2008, Tolen was convicted of 36 counts of statutory sodomy for engaging in sex with teenage boys between 1995 007, according to the AP. He was sentenced to two terms of 25 years for two counts of first degree statutory sodomy, ears for each of the 34 counts of second degree statutory sodomy and fined for witness tampering, the AP reports.

of the boys, who are now 18 years old, this week filed a lawsuit in St. Louis County seeking \$10 million in damages. In uit the boys claim that Tolen intended to do them bodily harm, according to the AP story.

g the criminal trial, prosecutors said Tolen asked boys to help him around his home and then would ask them to perform cts with him in exchange for gifts, according to AP.
