Former LSUPD officer charged for possession of child pornography — 12:50 p.m.

BATON ROUGE, La. (AP) — A longtime LSU police officer has been charged by the U.S. Attorney's Office for possession of child pornography.

Former Lt. Thomas Eugene Fife worked for 21 years at the LSU Police Department before FBI agents seized his work computer in July. The 62-year-old Fife immediately was placed on paid administrative leave, but resigned four days later.

Possession of child pornography is a felony offense that carries a possible prison term of 10 years.
