ONE of the NSW's most senior police commanders has been charged with possessing child pornography after being investigated by the force's corruption watchdog.

Superintendent Vivian "Rex" Little, who has worked in a number of regions across the state, was issued with a court attendance notice after an investigation by the Police Integrity Commission.

The notice, served in December last year, alleges one count of possessing child pornography between January 1 and January 31, 2006, at Eleena, outside <u>Newcastle</u>.

The 51-year-old, whose address is listed as at nearby Warner's Bay, first faced the Downing Centre Local Court in January.

In a brief mention yesterday, his solicitor Eric Oates indicated the matter would be defended, asking that the case proceed to a hearing.

It is not know what amount of child pornography was allegedly found on Mr Little's computer.
