

Snyder pleads guilty to six counts of criminal sexual conduct

In a court appearance Thursday afternoon before Koochiching County District Judge Charles LeDuc at the Itasca County Courthouse, former Itasca County Sheriff's Department Investigator Gregory Alan Snyder, 44, of Bovey pleaded guilty to six charges of criminal sexual conduct involving a minor. After the hearing, Snyder, who had been on house arrest, was taken into custody by Cass County and was later turned over to Crow Wing County, where he will be held pending his sentencing in March. He faces a minimum of 12 years in prison.

Prior to the hearing, a representative from Advocates for Family Peace, acting as spokesperson for the victim's family said the family did not wish to make a statement nor did they wish to be contacted.
