Tuskegee Police Officer Pleads Guilty to Rape



Tuskegee University police officer charged in October 2009 with the rape of a 15-year-old pleaded guilty Wednesday, according to a news release from the Alabama Department of Public Safety.

John Moon, 47, pleaded guilty to second-degree rape, first-degree sodomy and enticing a child for immoral purposes, the release states. He was sentenced to serve 20 years in prison, according to DPS.
