Former Waukesha Sheriff's deputy charged with sex assault, child enticement

Oconomowoc resident arrested Friday, posts \$100,000 cash bail

WAUKESHA - A retired Waukesha County Sheriff's Department deputy was arrested Friday and charged with seven counts of first degree sexual assault of a child, five counts of child enticement-sexual contact, three counts of second degree sexual assault of a child, two counts of child enticement-exposing a sex organ, and one count of causing a child aged 13 to 18 to view sexual activity, all felonies.

Terrence Greenwald, 55, of Oconomowoc was arrested Friday afternoon on the charges, said Lt. Brian Bortess with the sheriff's department. Greenwald posted cash bail of \$100,000 that afternoon, he said.

According to the criminal complaint filed Friday in Waukesha County Circuit Court, Greenwald repeatedly sexually assaulted a boy and girl over a period of several years, beginning when the victims were young children.

The girl told authorities Greenwald first sexually assaulted her in 1998, when she was in first grade. There were several other incidents over the years, the complaint states, including the last reported assault, which allegedly occurred in the fall of 2008. All of the incidents the girl alleged involved inappropriate touching and sexual contact, the

complaint states.
