
The Tennessee Bureau of Investigation has announced the arrest of a LaFollette Police officer on statutory rape charges.

Daniel Terry, 25, was indicted Friday on a count of official misconduct and three counts of statutory rape.

The TBI opened its case on February 19. According to the TBI, Terry was an officer at the time the offenses occurred against an underage female.

TBI agents arrested Terry Monday morning and booked him into the Campbell County Jail on \$15,000 bond.
