



Sheriff's Captain Arrested for Child Sex Assault

MILWAUKEE - A Milwaukee County sheriff's captain has been arrested for sexual abuse of a child. David Salsbury, 42, was arrested Tuesday while at a sheriff's office meeting at the Harley-Davidson Museum.

A Milwaukee police spokeswoman released a statement saying, "The Milwaukee Police Department arrested a member of the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office today on a charge of First Degree Sexual Assault of a Child. As this is an ongoing investigation, I have no further information to share with you at this time."

Salsbury works at the House of Correction in Franklin.

According to Salsbury's LinkedIn page, he's worked in law enforcement for almost twenty years - for 17 of those years, he's worked as a guard at the House of Correction, and was just recently promoted.

He's also a retired member of the Army National Guard, and even served as a spokesperson. TODAY'S TMJ4 has interviewed him several times.

His LinkedIn page also claims he's been awarded a Purple Heart.

No one was home when we went to his house, and the Sheriff's Office won't talk about the arrest.

Salsbury has not yet been charged. The district attorney's office expects to get the case Thursday and could issue charges after that.
