Sheriff's Captain Makes Court Appearance in Connection to Sex Crimes

MILWAUKEE -- Bail was set at \$500,000 Tuesday for a former Milwaukee County sheriff's captain charged with repeatedly sexually assaulting four children.

42-year-old David Salsbury made his initial court appearance Tuesday to hear a reading of the 18-count criminal complaint.

He's accused of sexually abusing two boys and two girls he knew over a period of 10 years.

Charges include 1st degree sexual assault of a child, repeated sexual assault of a child, child enticement and possession of child pornography.

According to the 11-page criminal complaint, the children came forward after learning from each other they had all been victimized.

Salsbury's attorney objected to the fact that his client was forced to wear a suicide gown and was shackled to a chair during today's appearance.

However, according to the complaint, Salsbury did threaten to "kill himself."

Salsbury was a captain at the Milwaukee County House of Correction.

He resigned Monday from the sheriff's department.

His preliminary hearing is scheduled for March 30th.

He faces a maximum sentence of 752 years in prison if convicted on all charges.
