## Chatham County deputy accused of molesting girl, 13, in Bryan County

A Chatham County Sheriff's deputy was fired after being arrested Sunday on child molestation charges in Bryan County, officials from both counties said Thursday evening.

Dustin McMillan was arrested May 30 on at least one molestation charge by Bryan County authorities, according to Ron Robinson, sheriff's spokesman. He was subsequently fired from his position as a correctional officer at the Chatham County jail, Robinson said, adding McMillan was terminated because he admitted to the allegations.

Bryan County Sheriff Clyde Smith said McMillan confessed his involvement to Bryan County Deputy Resa Lopez.

"He just got caught," Smith said late Thursday of McMillan. "He was charged with child molestation. ... He was arrested Sunday night. He has been charged, booked and bonded out on \$25,000 bail."

The victim -- who Robinson said was 13 years old -- was from Ellabell, Smith said.
