Elgin, ND (WDAY TV) - A former North Dakota Police Chief and judge plead guilty to three charges involving sex with a minor.

As part of a plea agreement, 49 other charges against 55-year-old Randall Hoffman were dropped. He'll be sentenced at a later date for the charges of continuous sexual abuse of a child, attempted gross sexual imposition and the corruption of minors.

Hoffman was charged in Grant County last year for molesting and trying to rape a teenage girl. He was the chief of police in Elgin, North Dakota for about 5 years and was also a state district judge for five years before resigning in 1999 after a disciplinary complaint.
