Authorities say a Greenwood police sergeant has been accused of trying to solicit a 14-year-old girl for sex.

The Greenwood Commonwealth reports that Robert Lewis has been charged with enticement of a child for a lustful purpose. He surrendered to authorities on Wednesday and has been released after posting \$10,000 bond.

Deputy Police Chief Huntley Nevels says the officer is on leave.

Department of Public Safety spokesman Jon Kalahar says the MBI is assisting in the investigation, and the probe is ongoing.

Attorney Carlos Moore, who represents the girl's family, says the alleged incident happened while the officer was off-duty.



There was no telephone listing for Robert Lewis in Greenwood and it was not immediately clear whether he has an attorney.
