VB officer pleads guilty, loses job

Receives two year suspended sentence

VIRGINIA BEACH, Va. (WAVY) - A former Master Police Officer with the Virginia Beach Police Department pleaded guilty to two counts of contributing to the delinquency of a minor last week, a spokeswoman for Commonwealth's Attorney office told WAVY.com.

Ronald S. Dunn was sentenced to 12 months on each count, with all that time suspended as long as he is on good behavior for two years.

Dunn was arrested in May for having inappropriate sexual relations with a minor. Police seized seized sexual paraphernalia, prescription medication and a computer amongst other items during a search of Dunn's home.

Dunn was hired by the police department in January 1990. He no longer works with the department.
