

Ex-state attorney's worker gets prison

A former investigator for the State Attorney's Office was sentenced to federal prison Friday for possessing child pornography. Sean Peters, 39, was ordered to serve just over four years in prison, followed by supervised release for life. Peters joined the Orange-Osceola State Attorney's Office in 2001 and worked there until 2007, when he learned federal officials were investigating him. Before that, he worked for the Ocoee and Apopka police departments. Peters was indicted last year and in October was convicted by an Orlando federal jury of one count of possessing child pornography.
