DENVER (AP) – A former Denver sheriff's deputy has pleaded guilty to one count of attempted sexual assault on a child.

Thirty-six-year-old Brennon Lonergan was accused of inappropriately touching a teenage girl in May 2009. Prosecutors said Monday that he faces up to six years in prison at a sentencing hearing scheduled for Nov. 7. He has been in custody since his arrest earlier this year.

Filed Under Another form

Another former Denver sheriff's deputy, 49-year-old Mark Davis, pleaded guilty earlier this year to child abuse and attempted sexual assault on a child on charges involving two victims. He was sentenced Monday to 24 years behind bars, followed by a 12-year sentence that's suspended if he successfully completes eight years of sex offender intensive supervision probation when he gets out of prison.
