Scott Bush, the Windermere man whose child-sex allegations sparked scandal in the city's Police Department, appeared in court on Thursday morning in Orange County, where a judge set a trial date in his case.

Barring any unforeseen complications, Bush will stand trial on sexual battery and lewd and lascivious molestation charges Dec. 3, Circuit Judge Julie O'Kane said. He faces up to life in prison if convicted as charged.

Bush's friend, former Windermere police Chief Dan Saylor, was removed from office after an investigation found he'd covered up the alleged child-rape, among other wrongdoing. Saylor was convicted of official

At a brief hearing Thursday, Bush was also granted permission to leave central Florida on business as necessary. He is currently out of jail on bond, but is subject to GPS monitoring as he awaits trial in the
