A former Lubbock police officer accused of sexual assault of a child now faces additional charges of sexual assault of an adult.

A new warrant has been issued for 32 year old <u>Jason Hignight</u>. It cites allegations of two incidents with the same woman in 2006 and 2007.


Hignight resigned as an LPD officer shortly before his arrest on January 18th.

According to the warrant, the mother of two girls caught Hignight exposing himself to one of them at their home and she took the children to talk to investigators.

Hignight remains jailed on \$200,000 bond for charges related to those allegations.
