

## Ex-trooper gets 15 years to life in sex abuse case

ST. GEORGE — A former Utah Highway Patrol trooper has been ordered to at least 15 years in prison in a child sex abuse case.

Kevin Davis, 61, of Washington City was sentenced last week after pleading guilty to two counts of felony child sex abuse. He's getting 15 years to life on each charge and is being ordered to serve the sentences concurrently.

The charges stem from separate incidents in November and December involving two girls younger than 14.

Authorities say he was first arrested after he was observed touching a young girl. In December, officials say a second girl told her father Davis had exposed himself to her.

Davis left the highway patrol in 2004.
