L.A. County OKs \$199,000 settlement in probation molestation case

Los Angeles County supervisors approved a \$199,000 settlement of a lawsuit brought by a teenager at a county probation camp who alleged that an officer molested him.

The 17-year-old boy, identified only as Alexis R, filed a lawsuit against the county earlier this year alleging that a female probation officer molested him at Camp Karl Holton in Sylmar on Aug 9, 2009, forcing him to touch her in a sexual manner.

The youth had been detained for running away from a court-ordered placement.

The district attorney's office is still evaluating whether to file charges against the officer, Nadia Polynice, who no longer works for the county.
