

SAN BERNARDINO: Ex-deputy's bail increased over postings

The bail for former San Bernardino County Sheriff's deputy Nathan James Gastineau was increased by \$200,000 to \$350,000 this morning after it was revealed that he made postings about "payback" and "revenge" on a Facebook page.

Gastineau is accused of having sex with a minor — a teenage girl he supervised at the Highland station as part of the Explorer program.

Gastineau had pleaded not guilty to three counts of lewd and lascivious acts with a child and three counts of illegal sexual intercourse with a minor.

Jason Henry Anguiano, 27, of Rialto — accused of assaulting the same girl — has pleaded guilty to unlawful sexual intercourse.

Los Angeles-based celebrity lawyer Gloria Allred is representing the 16-year-old girl.

In a separate case, Deputy Anthony Benjamin has pleaded not guilty to two counts of oral copulation with a minor in connection with a second Explorer.

The department has suspended Explorer ride-alongs in the wake of the cases.


