

I-Falls Customs and Border Protection Officer Arrested

An International Falls Customs Border Protection Officer was charged Thursday. He's accused of sexually assaulting a young girl multiple times over several years.

The Koochiching County Sheriff's Office arrested 45-year-old Patrick Hamburg on November 19th. In the criminal complaint, police said the Customs and Border Protection Officer admitted to the accusations, saying he felt terrible about what he had done.

According to the criminal complaint, Hamburg began sexually assaulting the girl in 2005. It extended over a four year period.

The report also stated Hamburg told the victim not to tell anyone or they would get in trouble.

Hamburg is now in custody and has been charged with three counts sexual assault in the first degree and one count of sexual assault in the second degree. Bail has been set at \$180,000.

U.S. Customs and Border Protection Public Information Officer Brian King said Hamburg worked as an officer for the International Falls Port of Entry for the past seven years. He said Hamburg had daily interaction with border crossers. Hamburg remains jailed in Koochiching County, but if he were released, the U.S. Customs and Border Protection Office said he would be reassigned to office duties.

Hamburg's court proceedings will likely move forward but at this point, there are no hearings scheduled.
