## Former Correctional Officer Sentenced in Sex Case

Johnny Walters, 40, was sentence on December 6, 2013, to 3 years 8 months in state prison for sexual acts involving minors. Walters pled no contest on October 11, 2013, to one count of child pornography and two counts of contact with a minor with the intent to commit a sexual offense. The three victims were present at the sentencing imposed by the Honorable William Garbolini. During the imposition of sentence the court commented on Walters' violation of a position of trust in that he was a correctional officer at the time he committed the offenses. In addition to the prison sentence, Walters was ordered to pay a \$1,200 restitution fine

and register as a sex offender for the rest of his life.

District Attorney Todd Riebe praised the victims for coming forward and the Amador County Sheriff's Office for their thorough investigation which resulted in the successful prosecution of Walters.
