A former Wichita police officer that pleaded guilty to sexual battery charges, will avoid jail time.

A judge sentenced Joseph McGill Friday to three years probation in connection to the sex crimes.

McGill was charged last year in two separate incidents in November 2010 and February 2011. Prosecutors said he inappropriately touched residents on two occasions while he was on duty. He pleaded guilty to the charges earlier this year.

McGill had been a police officer for three years. He resigned shortly after the charges were filed.

The judge said McGill will be ordered to prison if he violates probation terms.
