Ex-cop sentenced in child porn case

A former New Orleans police detective living in Titusville was sentenced to roughly eight years in federal prison Tuesday for possessing child pornography, the U.S. Attorney's Office reported.

Krister Kaj Vilen, 40, was also ordered to serve 10 years probation after he's released from prison. He pleaded guilty in Orlando federal court in June.

Man gets 27 years on Internet child-porn conviction

Prosecutors say Vilen used peer-to-peer software to obtain illegal images.

Agents who searched his Brevard County home in March found more than 100 images and movies depicting child pornography on his computers, court records said.

"This particular case is extremely disturbing because it involves a former New Orleans police detective," said Shane Folden, deputy special agent in charge of Homeland Security Investigations Tampa, which oversees the agency's Cocoa Beach office.

"Child predators prey on the weak and use positions of trust to commit their crimes. Homeland Security Investigations investigates child predators to the full extent of the law. We see that in this case; Vilen received significantly more time in prison than the minimum sentence dictates."
